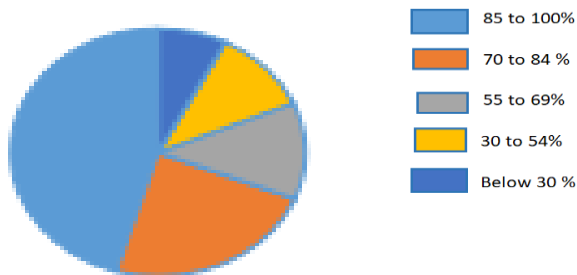

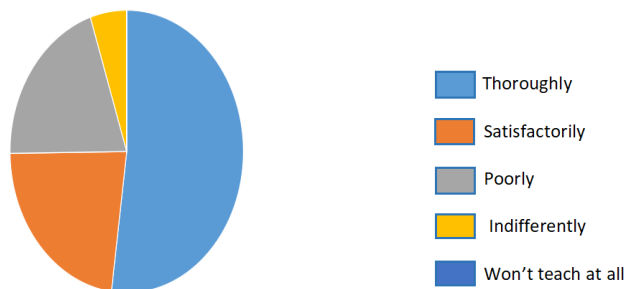

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

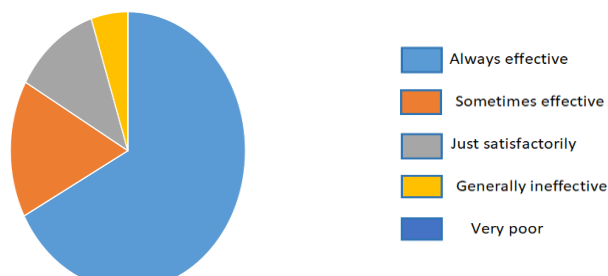

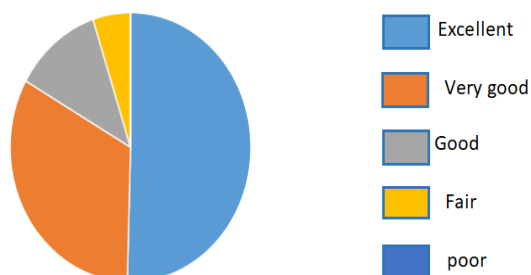
3. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?



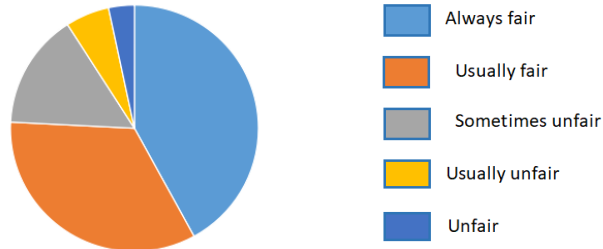

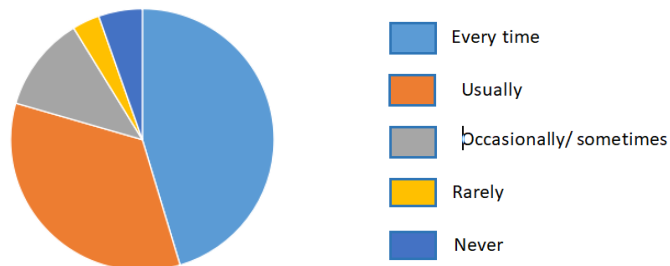

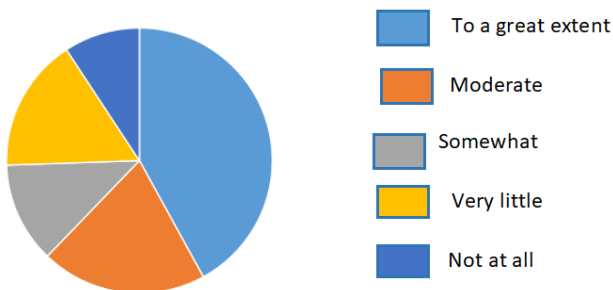

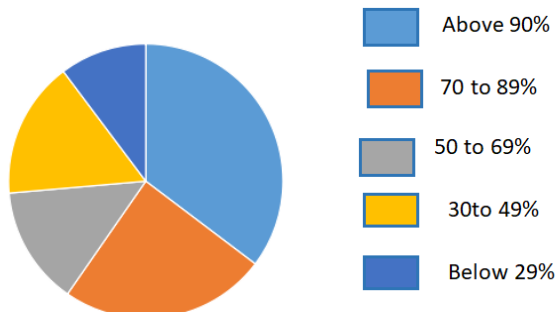
